We developed criteria for selecting good practices to ensure the quality of this product:

Effectiveness: The degree to which a measure or approach is informed or rooted in prior research or experience. Efficiency: Measure/approach with inplace quality assurance processes, including information on indicators, methods, or tools used throughout implementation.

Internal or external evaluation results: A measurable/applicable approach that has demonstrated its feasibility in the target group.

Some evidence of long-term viability: Measure/approach that has been used for a while and has received funding or other support (from a variety of stakeholders) for a few years in the future.



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
